'Worktown': The drawings of Falcon Hildred

Ers diwedd y 1950au, nod Falcon Hildred fu gwneud cofnod gweledol o adeiladau diwylliant diwydiannol a oedd yn prysur ddiflannu. Mewn llawer o ardaloedd, roedd yr hen ddiwydiannau'n methu, roedd cymunedau a oedd wedi'u hen sefydlu yn cael eu disodli gan gynlluniau tai enfawr ac roedd ailddatblygu trefol uchelgeisiol yn dechrau gfael. Ni allai Falcon wneud fawr ddim i atal hyn, ond fel dylunydd a darlunydd medrus gallai o leiaf sicrhau na fyddai adeiladau o'n gorffennol diwydiannol yn diflannu heb i ryw gofnod gael ei wneud ohonynt.

Pwrpas Prosiect Mynediad a Dysgu Falcon Hildred yw diogelu'r adnodd gwerthfawr hwn er mwynhad y cenedlaethau a ddaw, a hwyluso mynediad i'r casgliad drwy raglen gydgyssylltiedig o ddigido, cyhoeddi, arddangos ac addysgu ar hyd a lled Cymru a Lloegr.

Since the late 1950s, Falcon Hildred's mission has been to make a visual record of the buildings of a disappearing industrial culture. In many areas, old industries were collapsing, long-established communities were being replaced by mass housing schemes, and ambitious urban redevelopment was taking hold. Falcon could do little to halt this, but as a skilled designer and illustrator he could at least ensure that monuments of the industrial past did not disappear without a visual record.

The Falcon Hildred Access and Learning Project preserves this valuable resource for the enjoyment of future generations, and opens access to the collection through a co-ordinated programme of digitisation, publication, exhibition and education across England and Wales.

Dymchwel Penygroes, 1982

Demolition of Penygroes, 1982
A scene frequently captured during Falcon's lifetime of documenting buildings at risk has been that of demolition in progress. This terrace of slate workers' houses, known as Penygroes, was just below his home at Pant-yr-ynn mill in Bethania, Blaenau Ffestiniog.

Mae Comisiwn Brenhinol Henebion Cymru, gan weithio mewn partneriaeth ag Ymddiriedolaeth Amgueddfa Ceunant Ironbridge, a chyda chymorth Cronfa Dreftadaeth y Loteri, wedi prynu casgliad unigryw o fwy na 600 o luniadau gwreiddiol o adeiladau a thirweddau diwydiannol gan Falcon Hildred.

The Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments of Wales, working in partnership with the Ironbridge Gorge Museum Trust and with support from the Heritage Lottery Fund, has acquired a unique collection of over 600 original drawings of industrial buildings and landscapes by Falcon Hildred.
