Pontcysyllte World Heritage Site





Dynodwyd Dyfrbont a Chamlas Pontcysyllte yn Safle Treftadaeth Byd yn 2009 ar ôl gwaith cofnodi ac ymchwilio helaeth gan y Comisiwn Brenhinol. Mae'r ddyfrffordd arloesol yn symbol o'r newid o lwybrau cludo a lynnai'n glös wrth y dirwedd i'r rhai a frasgamai drosti. Bu'n fod i hwyluso cludo defnyddiau crai a nwyddau yn y bedwaredd ganrif ar bymtheg.

Pontcysyllte Aqueduct and Canal was inscribed as a World Heritage Site in 2009 following extensive recording and research by the Royal Commission. The pioneering waterway symbolises the transition from transport routes that simply followed the landscape to those that commanded it. Provided better transport for raw materials and goods during the nineteenth century.
