Chwith: Arferai ffyrnau clai fod yn gyffredin ym Mro Morgannwg. Caent eu cynhyrchu yng ngogledd Dynaint a'u halforio o'r ail ganrif ar bymtheg tan ganol y bedwaredd ganrif ar bymtheg. Ym Maendy-ganol, Llanfleiddan, y mae'r enghraifft hon.

Gan ddibynnu ar eu lleoliad a chyfoeth eu preswylwyr, yr oedd gan fythynnod wahanol fathau o loriau. Yn aml, byddai'r lloriau'n elfennol iawn ac wedi'u gwneud o bridd neu fwd. Er bod defnyddio cerrig i wneud lloriau yn llai cyffredin nag adeiladu â cherrig, llawr o gerrig palmant oedd i lawer o dai'r canolbarth. Ceid hefyd wahanol fathau o leoedd tân, ffyrnau, paredau, llofft yd addurniadau mewnol.

Cottages, depending on where they were and the means of their residents, had different kinds of floors. Floors were often very basic, made of earth or mud; the use of stone for flooring was less widespread than building in stone, but many houses in mid Wales had floors of pitched stone. There were also different types of fireplaces, ovens, partitions, lofts and interior decoration.

Uchod: Pared bangorwaith yn Wigwen-fach, Llanddewi Aber-arth, Sir Aberteifi. Diben cynnwys y pared oedd rhannu'r bwthyn yn ddwy. Yn ddiweddarach, torwyd twll yn y pared i greu drws rhwng y ddwy ystafell.

Above: A wattle partition at Wigwen-fach, Llanddewi Aber-arth, Cardiganshire. The partition was inserted to divide a cottage in two, and was later broken through to create a doorway between the two divisions.



Uchod: Ceid mentyll simneiau o fasgedwaith mewn bythynnod â waliau carreg hefyd. Dyma enghraifft ohonynt sydd wedi'i diogelu'n dda, yn Wigwen-fach, Llanddewi Aber-arth, Sir Aberteifi.
