Ceredigion: Education For All

Mae Ceredigion wedi chwarae rhan bwysig yn natblygiad pob lefel o addysg yng Nghymru. Ym 1872 sefydlwyd Coleg Prifysgol cyntaf Cymru ar lan y môr yn Aberystwyth. Agorwyd Coleg Dewi Sant, Llanbedr Pont Steffan ym 1827 a daeth yn rhan o Brifysgol Cymru ym 1971.

Ceredigion has played an important role in the development of all levels of education in Wales. In 1872 the first University College of Wales was established on the seafront at Aberystwyth. St David's College, Lampeter, was opened in 1827 and became part of the University of Wales in 1971.
