




Bryndraenog (Beguildy): one of the grandest timber halls in Wales and associated with Richard Plantagenet, Duke of York and lord of Maeienydd. It was built from timber felled in 1436, and a poem in praise of the new-built house by Ieuan ap Hywel Swrdwal has survived
